Third and Final Reading of an Ordinance Adopting Speed Limit Changes and School Zones on Various Streets Within the City of Mansfield

A motion was made by Council Member Broseh to approve the third and final reading of the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 73 OF THE TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 545.356 OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY TO ALTER SPEED LIMITS ON SPECIFIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS BEING AN ORDINANCE ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIA SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 545.352 OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE, REGULATING SPEED LIMITS ON HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS, UPON THE BASIS OF AN ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC INVESTIGATION WITHIN THE CORPORATE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD AS SET OUT IN THE ORDINANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

A motion was made by Council Member Rudnicki to approve as stated the second reading of "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2009 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2010, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS AMOUNTS THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE" including the recommendation by the subcommittee in regard to the hotel-motel tax with the only addition being the sum of \$10,000 being allocated for the hotel association which is to be formed prior to any funds being disbursed. Ordinance - Second Reading of Ordinance Levying the Ad Valorem Taxes for Fiscal Year 2010 at a Rate of \$0.71000 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100) Assessed Valuation on all Taxable Property

A motion was made by Council Member Leyman to approve the second reading of "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANSFIELD, TEXAS, LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 AT A RATE OF \$0.7100 PER ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) ASSESSED VALUATION ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AS OF JANUARY 1, 2009, TO PROVIDE REVENUES FOR THE PAYMENT OF CURRENT EXPENDITURES AND TO PROVIDE AN INTEREST AND SINKING FUND ON ALL OUTSTANDING DEBTS OF THE CITY; THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE LESS TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE; THE TAX RATE WILL LOWER TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$42.00; PROVIDING FOR DUE AND DELINQUENT DATES TOGETHER WITH PENALTIES AND INTEREST; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE." Seconded by Council Member Broseh, the motion CARRIED with the following vote:
